The State of Cyber Crime and Ransomware Today



Cyber Crime on track to be a **\$10.5T** business by 2025 (15% y/y growth)



More profitable than all illicit drug trade world-wide



More than **60 'nationally significant' attacks** in the last year were dealt with by National Cyber Security Centre



UK councils are being hit by **10,000 cyber-attacks every day** so far in 2022



81% of UK healthcare organisations suffered a ransomware attack in the last year



3 months on NHS trusts still reporting "chaos" after ransomware attack in August 2022



94% of UK security leaders reported a significant emotional or psychological impact after an attack



22% of UK organisations are struggling with insufficient talent, **3.5 million** unfilled cyber roles
